- The permit process will not begin until the \$3,000.00 processing fee has been received.
- The required Force Account Estimate must be paid and the insurance policies reviewed and approved before executed permit or license agreement can be issued & work can be scheduled.
- To ensure proper routing of FAE invoices, please email the appropriate billing contact information, including the company name, business address, person's name, email address, and telephone number.
- You will be contacted by email when the permit process is completed.
