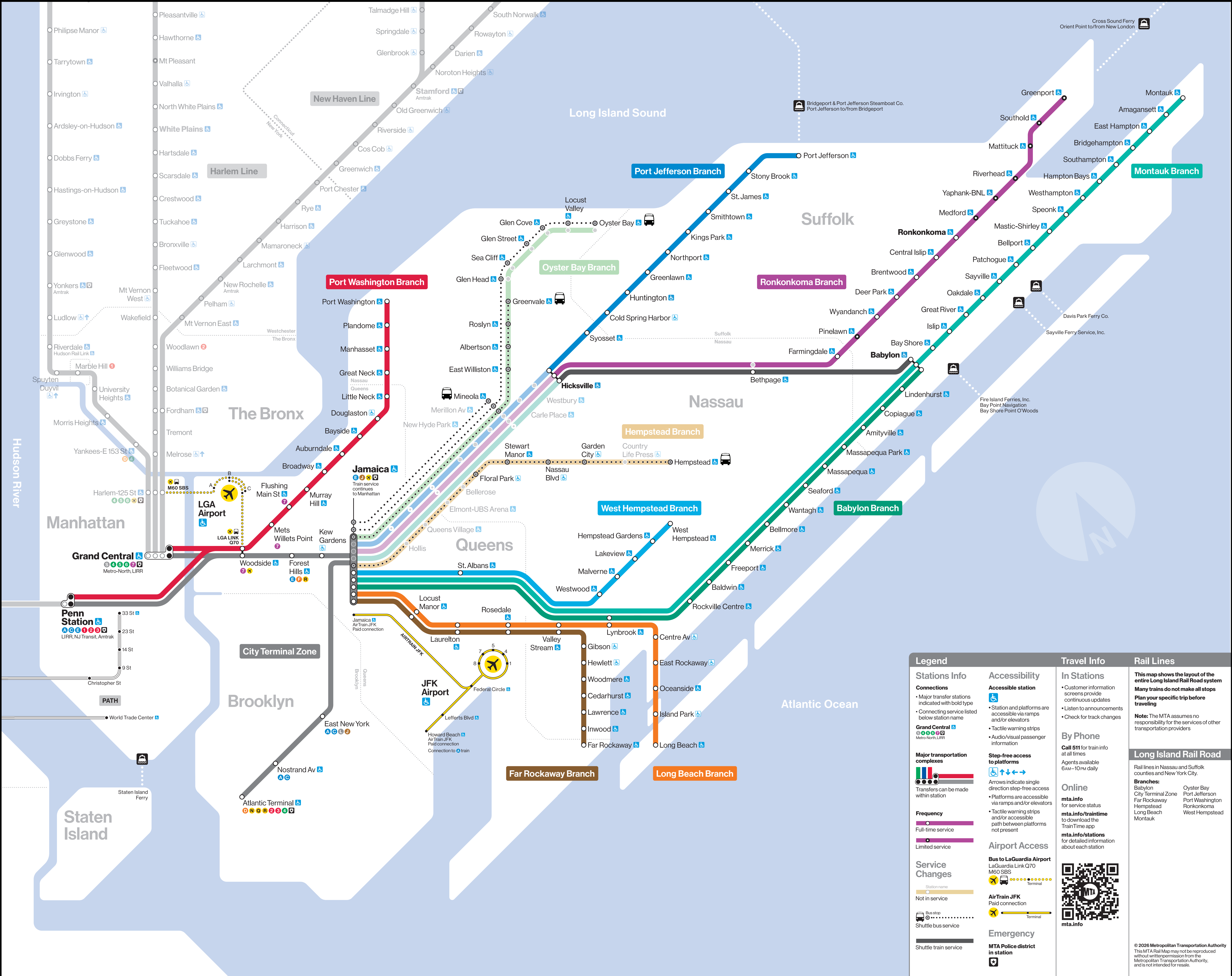




Long Island Rail Road | Service Changes July 25 – 26
